Type of assistance	Loans in different fields including the environmental sector. In addition, the bank appears in the same rank as the executive organs of the Global Environment Facility (GEF) and has a direct access to the resources of the project. This direct access allow him (i) to identify, prepare, evaluate and execute projects under the GEF's name, (ii) to submit directly entire project propositions with a view to funding, which means without the intervention of an executive organ and (iii) directly receive donations in favour of their projects and being directly responsible of their utilization.
