It does this in coordination with the State Department for International Cooperation (SECI).</p> <p>Among Spain's thematic program areas for its ODA are: Rural Development and Food Security; Water and Sanitation; and Environmental Sustainability and Climate Change. AECI funds a few specific programs with strong connections to environment and natural resources</p>

General procedure and condition for financial contribution	<p>Grant Programs for Agriculture, Energy, Environment, and Natural Resources</p> <p>-Framework Agreements with Spanish NGOs: Spanish NGOs accredited by AECID as "qualified development NGOs" can apply under this grant-making program. Grant agreements are signed between the NGO and AECID according to a detailed contractual work plan. Framework grants can address various areas and sectors, and they can support activities in one or more countries.</p>

Information or documentation required

-Development Projects with Spanish NGOs: Projects are defined to have a single development objective in a single country. This program is open to Spanish NGOs which meet AECID's requirements on legal status, NGO registry, and previous development experience. Groups of several NGOs are eligible to apply, but each NGO must comply with AECID's criteria.

- Open and Ongoing Cooperation Activities and Development Aid: The CAP refers to announced calls for proposals. Spain identifies specific priorities in each call, and it may announce several calls each year. Eligibility is defined in each call for proposals, including calls open to non-Spanish applicants.

-Grants in Spain's Partner Countries: AECID has the possibility to make grants through its country-level offices to support development strategies at national and local levels. Eligible recipients are legally recognized national and international organizations (public, private, and NGO).

- Framework Agreements with Spanish NGOs and Grants to Spanish NGOs for Development Projects: Spain's Official State Bulletin (BOE) publishes annual announcements for each of these programs. AECID's website also publishes them, provides application forms, and indicates accompanying materials to be submitted.
- Open and Ongoing Cooperation Activities and Development Aid (CAP): Calls for proposals are published on AECID's website. AECID provides the application forms, and it indicates the accompanying materials which must be submitted. Applications from outside of Spain normally are submitted through Spain's embassies or consulates, or through AECID's technical cooperation offices, at country level.
- Cooperation Fund for Water and Sanitation: AECID provides web pages about this Fund, including an email address for contact. In each eligible country of Latin America, grant seekers consult AECID's internet site at the country level. Information is also available through the Water and Sanitation Division, Inter-American Development Bank.
- Grants in Spain's Partner Countries: Grant seekers should contact AECID's technical cooperation offices (or diplomatic missions) at the country level to inquire for information. Many of AECID's technical cooperation offices have country websites, particularly in Latin America.
